You will have a mentoring session once every two weeks with your form tutor and a few members of your form group.

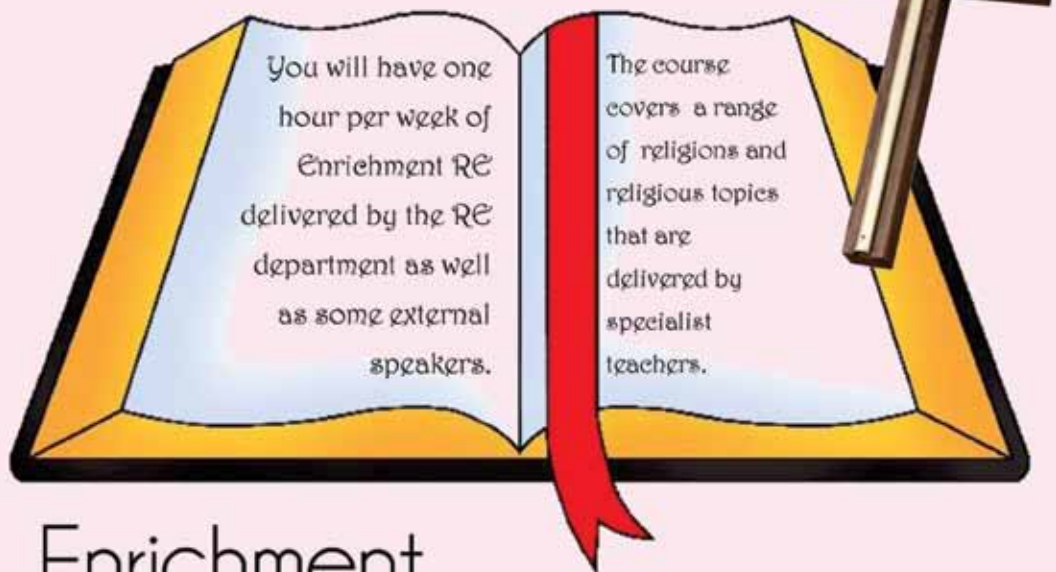
These sessions are there to support you and enable you to develop a relationship with your form tutor.

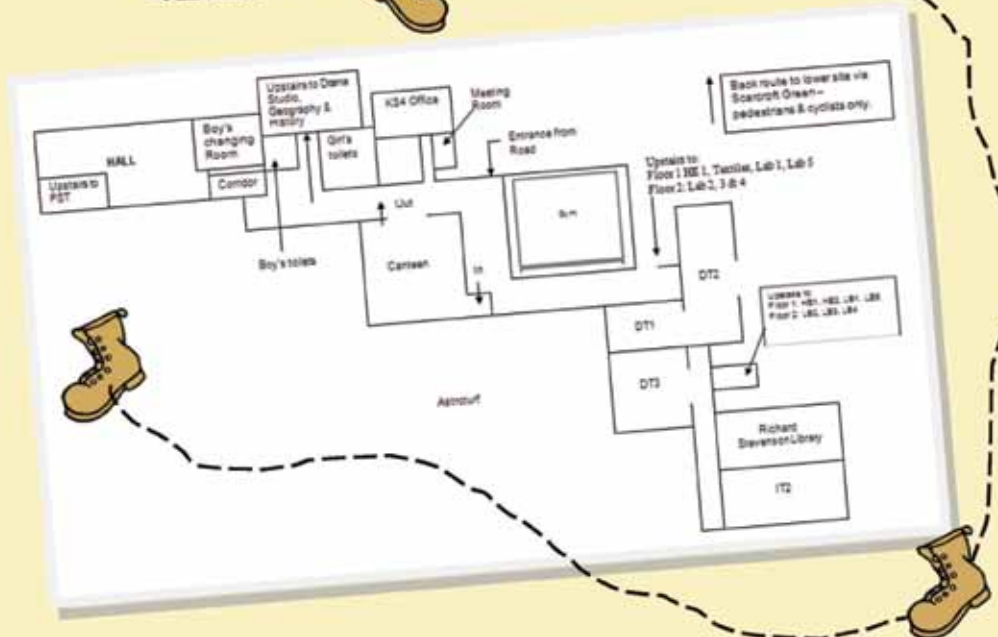
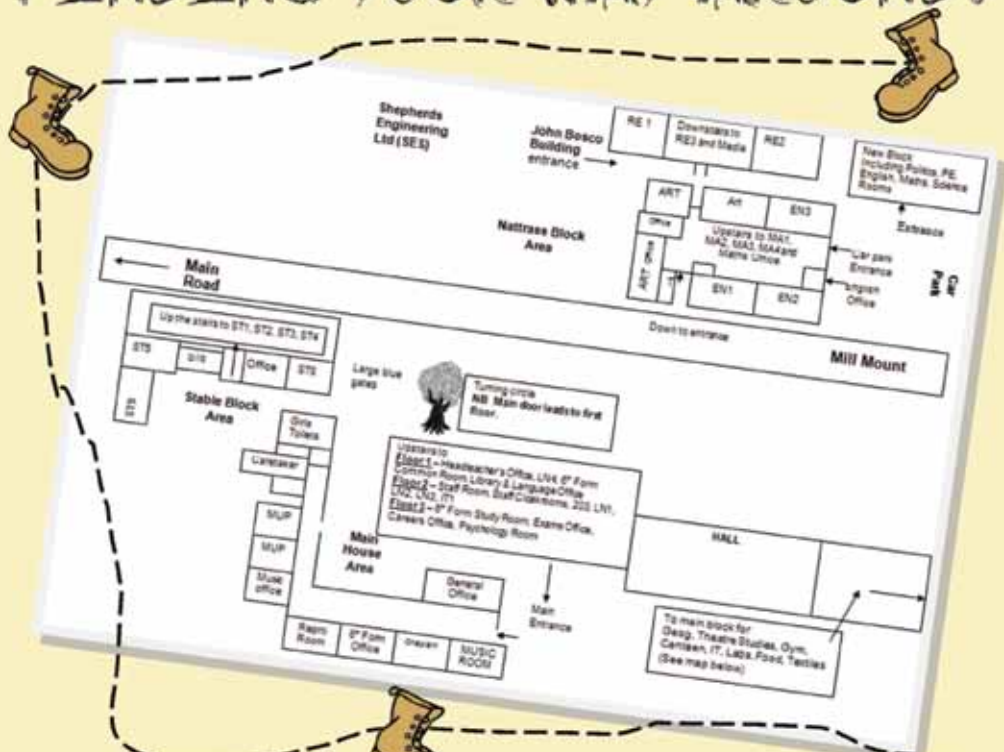

Things you need to know...

Absence from school

If you need to be off school for a particular reason you **MUST** contact the Sixth Form Admin Team via phone or email so that they can update the registers (your subject teachers are not able to do this).

Attendance is monitored with 95% as a baseline. If attendance falls below 95% this may jeopardise exam entry.

You are permitted to leave site when you have **FREE PERIODS**, during **BREAKS**, and at **LUNCHTIME**

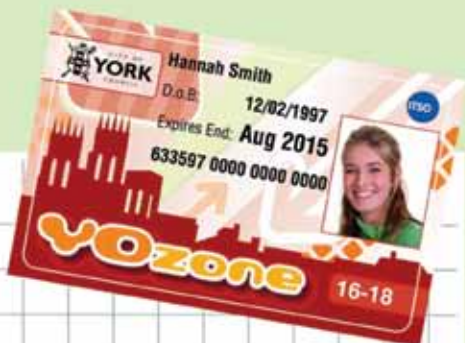
It is vital that during **FREE PERIODS** you **sign in and out** in the Sixth Form Office so that if there were an emergency we would know who is and who is not in the building.

PROGRESS RECORDS

You will receive regular Progress Records containing your target grades, your most recent assessment grades, and predicted grades based on your ability and performance.

These are made accessible via **My Child At School (MCAS)** where parents/guardians can log-on and view (all parents/guardians will be emailed log-in details, contact the Sixth Form Team if this has not been received).

Alongside this academic account you will also receive an 'Approach to Learning' (ATL) score from each of your subjects based on your effort level, attendance, punctuality and organisation. If your ATL score is inadequate then you will closely monitored and receive sanctions.

Attendance is monitored monthly and parents and students will be notified of concerning levels. Absence is only acceptable where students are not well enough to attend. Any other events, appointments etc. should be scheduled outside of school time. The Sixth Form Team should be notified by parents/guardians of any absence via phone or email.

Representatives from each Tutor Group in the school make up the student council.

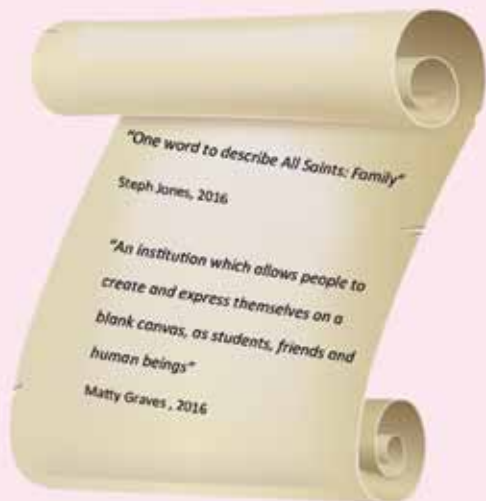
Council meetings are held periodically and
